

**English as a Second Language (E.S.L.)
Financial Agreement
Inservice Teachers**

I understand that I must notify the ESL Project Director at UTC if changes in my employment occur prior to the completion of the ESL Additional Endorsement Program, and that failure to do so may make me ineligible for continuation in the program.

I understand also that if I do not complete a course which has been paid for under the terms of the U.S.D.E. grant mentioned above, and do not drop the course by the last date for withdrawal without fee obligation (as designated in the UTC Timetable,) I will be obligated to repay the tuition cost for this course before continuing in the ESL Additional Endorsement Program at UTC.

I understand that unsatisfactory grades in courses covered by the grant make me ineligible to complete future coursework under the grant program. In addition, late changes in course credit from graduate to undergraduate will result in my ineligibility to continue in the grant program.

I understand that the grant awards are given on a first come first serve basis and the amounts of grants given each semester are limited. I am aware that the grant award only covers up to six hours of undergraduate in-state tuition per semester. If I would like to take the class for graduate credit I may pay the difference. If I am an out-of-state student, I must pay the balance remaining after the grant has been awarded. I also understand that I may take more than six hours of ESL related coursework per semester, but the additional hours will not be covered under the grant program.

In addition, I understand that the grant does not pay for courses beyond full-time status. In other words, if I am enrolled full-time and add an ESL course, the grant will not pay for the course as it is no additional cost. Also, I understand the ESL grant program expires September 2007; however, the UTC ESL Program will continue.
